

### Key highlights

#### Back to School Programme

The yearly Back-to-School Programme is designed to establish a safe, caring and enabling environment and help our students transition smoothly into the new school year. The programme focuses on making the students feel welcomed, safe, and connected to the school community. The various segments carried out at the school, cohort, class and individual levels build students' emotional readiness, strengthen relationships, and reinforce positive routines and expectations. Through structured activities and positive interactions with teachers and peers, students are made aware of the school expectations and supported in settling into school routines.



## Primary 1 Recess Buddy Programme

The Recess Buddy Programme is an annual initiative where our Primary 1 students are paired with Primary 4 students to ease their transition into a new school environment.




## Chinese New Year Celebrations
